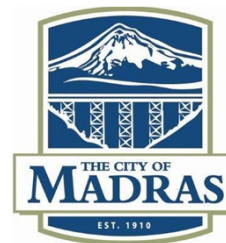

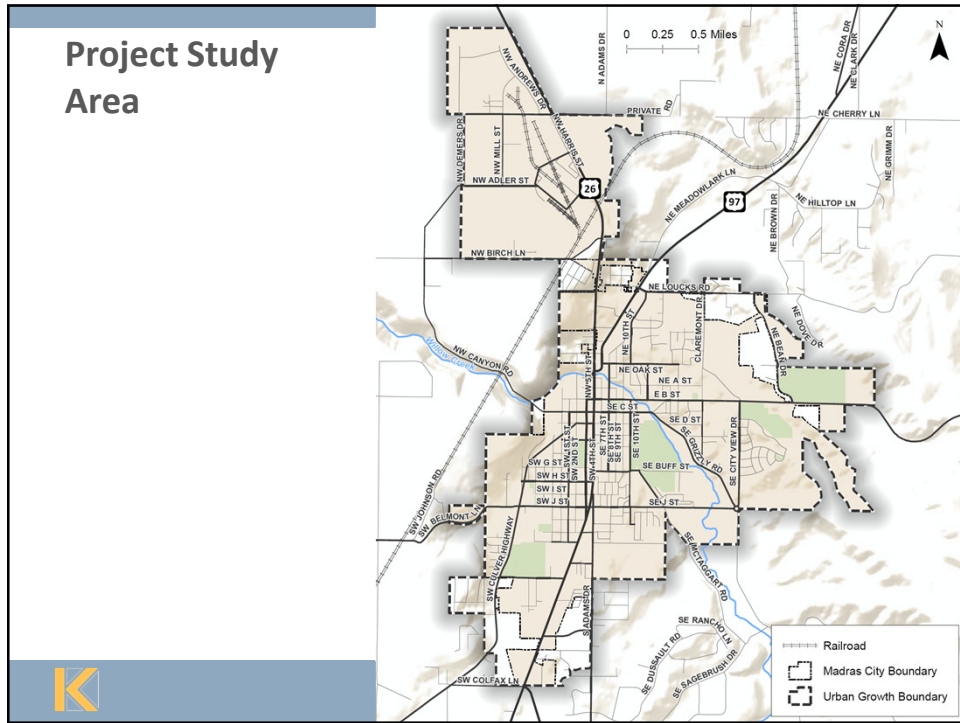

Technical & Public Advisory Committee (TAC & PAC)

- Review draft memoranda prior to TAC/PAC meetings
- Attend and actively contribute input to TAC/PAC meetings
- Attendance at public workshops is recommended
- Represent technical/community interests

Consultant Team

- Facilitate TAC/PAC meetings
- Provide draft reports to the TAC/PAC with adequate time for review prior to meetings
- Consult with ODOT on technical analysis methodology
- Attend and facilitate Public Workshops
- Provide final reports, incorporating comments from the TAC/PAC and public



Material Review Process

- Week 1: Consultant Provides Draft Documents to City and ODOT Project Managers
- Week 2: City and ODOT provide comments on the draft documents to consultant team
- Week 3: Consultant revises documents and provides draft documents to TAC and PAC
- Week 4: Consultant conducts TAC and PAC meetings to discuss materials and key issues
- Week 5: TAC provide written comments and feedback
- Week 6: Consultant team incorporates comments and feedback into final materials

- **Environment:** balance transportation services with the need to protect the environment.
